ORIGINALITY POLICY

Only original works may be submitted to this exhibit—this means that the subject of the entry must be a concept entirely developed by the submitting artist and executed by their own hand.

Duplications of another's photograph or art, whether by machine or paint, is considered copyright infringement and may not hang in VAC's regular exhibits. Any found to be a duplication will be removed and any awards revoked.

Reproductions of your work are not eligible for exhibition.

STUDENT-TEACHER SHOW

PUBLIC VIEWING: SEPTEMBER 7-23, 2010

Open to all painting and drawing mediums, scratchboard, handprinting techniques, collage, computer-generated art, photography, jewelry and sculpture. Maximum of 3 entries per artist.

ALL WORKS

Must be completely original (see other side).
Must have been completed within the past year.
Must not have been previously exhibited at the VAC.
Must not be removed prior to the exhibit unless sold and removed by purchaser. Artist may provide a replacement.
Must be picked up at the specified date and time. The Center cannot provide storage—you will be assessed \$1/day storage fee!
Must have artist's name and phone number on back.

2-D WORK

Must be properly framed using ONLY plexiglass. NO glass is allowed *except* for works in pastel and charcoal. Cannot exceed 25 lbs. and must be ready to hang with securely fastened picture wire. The center of the wire should be at least 3" from the top of the frame when hung. Artwork not properly ready for hanging will not be accepted.

3-D WORK

Should fit safely upon a 12" round pedestal or directly on the floor. Artist may provide own pedestal if clean and attractive; VAC has a limited number of pedestals.

FEES

This is a learning experience, and to encourage participation, it's only \$2 per entry. **All fees are non-refundable.** VAC Commission on sales is 30%.
